#### **COLLEGE REPORTS**

Bakersfield College (Shawn Newsom)

- UDOIT will be required every semester.
- Online RSI Training:
  - A new committee will review faculty courses and training will be mandatory in order to teach online. People will have to be certified to teach online.
  - Classes will be offered in the Spring and Summer in order to give people the opportunity to complete the courses.
  - Questions were asked about the plan for compensation for faculty to attend these trainings.
    - This relates to a Workload Issue.
  - Questions surrounding past trainings, such as POOCR not being grandfathered in, were asked.
  - CCA has not approved anything regarding this effort.
  - It was stated by representatives from both Cerro Coso and Porterville College that the reason they are good with RSI now is that they had faced potential consequences during previous evaluations.

Cerro Coso Community College (Michael Bonner)

- Single Point of Contact
  - District Office is aware of Banner 9 issues.
    - One continued issue is the Banner 9 roster. Banner 8 version is preferred.
  - Cerro Coso went through accreditation and site visit last Monday. They were highlighted on:
    - DE
    - Ability to Communicate Across all Campuses
  - Enrollment is up 12%. Highest in 10yrs.
- Michael Bonner is now the Treasurer of the Academic Senate.
  - Working to bring CC's more in line with other Academic Senate Treasurers.
- Housing at the District Office
  - A question was asked about this housing.
  - The district has property near the district office.
    - Modular housing.
    - Individuals delivering or receiving long-term training at the District Office can be housed there.
    - Facilities can also be rented out to others.

Porterville College (Jeff Keele)

- Conducted a training for Mode-A Evaluations. The majority of the new faculty attended.
- A meeting with the Interim President was held.
